

Caritas Event Volunteers

The Caritas Events Volunteer role is for people who are keen to support people across the diocese to learn more about specific issues and explore solutions to share the love and mercy of God in practical ways. This is done through diocese wide in person and online events and road shows. Volunteers are essential for the smooth and safe running of events but are also an opportunity to also become more involved and meet new people with the same passion and interest to help those in need.

We are looking for volunteers who can help with one (or more) of the following

- Administrative support, including registrations, bookings and communications
- On the day activities, putting up/taking down gazebo's, tables and chairs etc
- Hospitality, welcoming visitors, organizing and serving refreshments

Our team will ensure you have the training and resources necessary for you to carry out your role.

You will be part of our Caritas Portsmouth volunteer team so will receive regular updates on activity across the diocese, as well as participate in volunteer events where you have the chance to meet other volunteers, exchange ideas and suggestions as well as develop, pray and reflect.

Frequently asked questions

What is the time commitment for this role?

We plan to host events throughout the year in different regions across the diocese, so ideally you will support events in areas fairly close to you. As such there may not be many to support within a year. When we have an event planned, we'll be in touch to see if you are free and what the needs of the specific event are.

Can I do this role alongside another Caritas volunteer role?

Yes, you can. This role is ideal to do along with the Caritas Parish Rep or Caritas School roles.

Will I need a DBS for this role?

You do not currently need a DBS for this role.
