Points and tips from discussion

- Helpful to have a small group of committed people to get going, even if the rest of the parish don't seem to initially be on board.
- Can include what parishes are already doing so if you have a foodbank collection point already going, that counts as part of your actions with living in solidarity with the poor.
- Record your actions and take pictures—this will be needed as part of the assessment.
- Social events work well (plant sales, seed swaps) especially when there is tea and cake.

- For people struggling to engage parishes
 - Making a list of all the things already happening that fall within the 3 categories of the award, living simply, sustainably and in solidarity with the poor.
 - o Increasing activity in these three areas, without necessarily committing to the award initially.
 - Using the above to demonstrate how the parish is already on the way to achieving the award.
